Collingwood was founded in 1929 as a Boys' School and was constituted as an Educational Trust in 1978. The school became co-educational in September 1991 and has flourished into the school it is today.

It is a place where our boys and girls are also challenged to be the best that they can possibly be. Beyond the high academic expectations, our pupils are inspired to develop their talents in arts, music and sports.
